THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

A Nation Cup Team consists of following Categories:

- One Individual Female 2*
- One Individual Male 2*
- One Pas de Deux
- One Team 2*

Each Nation can only participate with a maximum of two Nation Cup Teams.

The composition of the Nation Cup Teams must be declared on Thursday, 21st May 2009 at 4 p.m.

The starting Order of the Nation Cup Teams will be determined by a separate draw.

A Nation Cup Team has to compete in a minimum of three Categories to be counted. One of the Three must be the Team category. The Team classification will be determined by adding together the three best scores, the fourth is a scratch result.

Competition 4: Team Vaulting Competition

CVIO2*

A vaulting team is composed of the longer and seven vaulters and one vaulting horse. This competition will take place in one round.

Entry Fee: € 70,--

Competition 5: Pas-de-Deux

CVIO2*

The Pas-de-Deux Competition is composed of two vaulters, the longer and the vaulting horse. This competition will take place in one round. The starting order of the Pas-de-Deux's participating on the same horse will be decided by the longer.

Entry Fee: € 40,-- ✓

Competition 6: Team Vaulting Consolidation Competition

CVIO2*

A vaulting team is composed of the longer and seven vaulters and one vaulting horse. The Team will show on round of freestyle. This completion is open for Teams not starting in Competition 1. ✓

Entry Fee: € 15,--

Competition 7: Junior Team Vaulting Competition

CVI1*

A junior vaulting team is composed of the longer and seven less than 16 years old vaulters and one vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two rounds, the second round consisting of only free test. The 12 best Teams of the first round are allowed to start in the second round.

Entry Fee: €90,-- ✓

Competition 8: Individual Vaulting Competition

CVI1*

The age is limited from 14 to 18 years. The competition will be held in 2 rounds. In the 2nd round, the 25% best placed vaulters of the 1st round may start. The starting order of the Vaulters participating on the same horse will be decided by the longer.

Entry Fee: €50,-- ✓

Competition 9: Individual Male Vaulting Competition

CVI1*

The age is limited from 14 to 18 years. The competition will be held in 2 rounds. In the 2nd round, the 25% best placed vaulters of the 1st round may start. In the first round the Vaulters passage depends on the horses' draw lots. The starting order of the Vaulters participating on the same horse will be decided by the longer.
